Microenterprise Development Organization of Cotogo – MDOC

- Beginning of Operations: 2004
- Coverage: 3 branches in Cotogo
 - 2 branches in Northern Cotogo; 2,856 clients total
 - 1 branch in Eastern Cotogo; 1,144 clients total
- Programs: Individual Credit (75% of all clients), Savings Only (15%), Business Development Skills training (10%)
- Portfolio: US\$400,000
- Number of clients: 4,000 (90% women)
- Credit average: US \$80
- Funding sources: National Bank of France and USAID

Center for Microenterprise Development in Cambodia – CMEDL

- Beginning of Operations: 1998
- Coverage: 7 branches in Cambodia
 - 3 branches in the Southern Cambodia; 26,435 clients
 - 2 branches in Far Western Cambodia; 7,248 clients
 - 2 branches in the Lake Region of Cambodia; 9,317 clients
- Programs: Agro-commercial loans, Small business loans
- Portfolio: US\$12,000,000
- Number of clients: 43,000 (75% of total are women and 30% of total are rural)
- Credit average: US \$200
- Funding sources: Southeast Asian Development Institute and USAID
